BEEF CATTLE REGULATIONS:

1. All cattle must be tagged with NLIS Tag.
2. Cattle owners/exhibitors must submit a National Vendor Declaration (eNVD) and Waybill for consignment to **PIC NK464614** Shoalhaven City Council at Kangaroo Valley Showground, 181 Moss Vale Road, Kangaroo Valley, NSW 2577.
3. All cattle to enter showgrounds via Gate 1 on Moss Vale Road next to Glenmack Caravan Park.
4. Owners/exhibitors must be in total control of cattle.
5. Cattle to be stalled by 8.30am in allocated areas and ready when Stewards call their class.
6. Age as at 1 March.
7. All exhibits under 18 months may be mouthed prior to judging in accordance with RAS regulations. Cattle not complying will be re-graded accordingly.
8. All bulls over 12 months must be rung. All bulls under 12 months to have a nose grip.
9. All females must be paraded with a nose grip.
10. A calf of the exhibit is admitted if it is under the age of 8 months on the day and is being suckled by the exhibit.
11. All cattle must be paraded on the day of the show as Committee requires. All ribbon winners to join the Grand Parade.
12. Duplicate or photocopy of registration certificate of Pure Bred Cattle must accompany entries, for return on judging day.
13. Exhibitors to supply their own bedding and water trough/bucket. Cattle will not be able to access communal water troughs.
14. All cattle must comply with NSW Department of Agriculture Health Regulations.

ECM LIVESTOCK MOSS VALE JUNIOR STEER COMPETITION

Sponsored by ECM Livestock Moss Vale

1. Prizes: 1st \$250, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$100 and awarded at the conclusion of the Group 5 Show season
2. The class is for a steer showing no permanent teeth, to be prepared and exhibited by a full time school student under 18 years of age as at 30 June 2025
3. The Steer and handler must be the same for each Show in this class
4. to be judged taking into consideration student handling and knowledge
5. the beef sub-committee recommends that the competition be judged the first steer class on the day. Results to be withheld and announced at the completion of the steer judging.
6. points to be awarded to a maximum of 10 placings and each competitor receives 10 points for attendance
7. Competitors in the Junior Steer Competition are encouraged to exhibit in other open steer classes that may be scheduled on the day. Where schools are exhibiting, other students may parade the steer competing in the Junior Steer Competition in an open class.
