BEEF CATTLE YOUNG JUDGING COMPETITION

The South Coast and Tablelands Show Societies Inc (Group 5) have organised a Beef Cattle Young Judging Competition to be held on Fri 17 Feb at Kangaroo Valley Showground commencing at 9.00am sharp.

Competitors will be asked to judge three groups of cattle - consisting of four head in each group, placing them in their respective order of 1st, 2nd 3rd & 4th. Each group will judge the three groups of cattle in rotation. 50 points will be allocated for the placement of each group for a total of 150 points. On completion of the judging up to 10 top marked competitors in the senior and intermediate sections will be asked to give, over the microphone, their comments on the placement of their nominated breed. A further 50 points will be allocated for this oral section.

Two competitors, aged over 15 and under 25 years as at 1 May 2023, will be selected on the day to represent Group 5 at the 2023 Sydney Royal Show to compete in the State Beef Cattle Junior Judging Competition.

Competitors can compete in only one Group Final but it is not necessary to reside within the boundaries of the Group conducting the Final. No competitor can represent more than one Show Society in any Group Final and no more than one group in a State Final. The winners of the National Final cannot compete at any level in the particular competition that they won.

Entries will be accepted on judging morning up until 8.30am. However, to assist with catering and administration it would be appreciated if schools could advise the number of anticipated competitors and send completed entry forms by Fri 10 Feb to the Secretary Sue Sharpe on 02 46580897 or mobile 0410545463.

It will be assumed that schools not replying by Fri 10 Feb will not be attending and will not be catered for.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS:

1. Age as at 1 March
2. Duplicate or photocopies of Registration Certificate or Pure Bred Stud Cattle **MUST** accompany entries, which will be retained and returned on judging day.
3. All bulls over 12 months must have a ring attached to nose. Bulls under 12 months must have a nose grip or ring.
4. All females must be paraded with nose grip at all times.
5. All Steers must not be showing permanent teeth and can be purebred or crossbred.

1. Prizes: 1st \$150, 2nd \$100, 3rd \$50 and awarded at the conclusion of the Group 5 Show season.
2. The class is for a steer showing NO permanent teeth, to be prepared and exhibited by a full time school student or exhibitor under 18 years of age as at 30 Jun 2023.
3. The steer and handler must be same for each Show in this class.
4. To be judged taking into consideration student handling and knowledge.
5. The beef sub-committee recommends that the competition be judged the first steer class on the day. Results to be withheld and announced at the completion of the steer judging.
