Conditions

- Public Health regulations expect that pasteurised milk will be used in the making of cheese and dairy produce entered in the show. Entries made with unpasteurised milk will be judged but need to be clearly identified.
- Judging will be based on flavour, texture, aroma and look of the cheese or dairy product. Stewards will provide a suitable plate on which your entries will be displayed.
- To ensure entries are placed in the correct category, stewards will confirm details when the entry is delivered.
- Only amateur cheesemakers are eligible to submit entries.
- Weight of cheese exhibited should be approximately 250g and should be presented whole and uncut. Larger cheeses may be presented as a whole or a sample piece of 250g may be submitted. Yoghurt should be at least 250ml and presented in a clear glass container.
- The general order of judging will be juniors, butter, yoghurt, fresh cheeses, soft cheeses, semi hard, hard, blue and washed rind cheeses.
- Judging will be open to the public, which presents a unique opportunity for entrants and the public, to learn more about the way cheeses are assessed and how to choose a good cheese.
- Depending on the number of entries, the judging may take several hours.

How to Enter

- All entries must be registered at www.kangaroovalleyshow.org.au.
- Entry closing time is 8am Fri 17 Feb.
- Entries must be delivered to a steward at the hall between 1-6pm Thurs 16 Feb or between 7-8.30am on Fri 17 Feb.

- Champion Dairy Product: Perpetual Trophy, Ribbon and \$100 donated by **VALLEY CHEESEMAKERS**.

- Trophy and Ribbon awards will be made directly after the Judging on Fri 17 Feb.

The Pavilion Events include Section 5-16. Below is important information that applies to all Sections. Please also see individual Sections and Classes.

Event Time:

- The Pavilion Events occur in the Pavilion and in the Main Hall.
- The Pavilion is open on Fri 17 Feb from 1-8pm and Sat 18 Feb from 9am to 5pm.
- The Pavilion will be closed for judging on Fri 17 Feb between 9am and 1pm.
- The Main Hall is open Fri 17 Feb from 1-8pm and Sat 18 Feb from 9am to 5pm.

Conditions

- Every article must have been made or grown by the exhibitor or a member of the household.
- Exhibitors are asked to display exhibits in suitable containers where relevant.
- No exhibit will be received unless entry ticket is attached.

How to Enter and Deliver Exhibit

- Entry is free.
- Membership is available online until Thurs 16 Feb (unless otherwise stated in each Section). All Junior Pavilion entries are free.
- Entries must be made online at www.kangaroovalleyshow.org.au or in person at the Show Office during Show Office hours.
- Please note that there will be different times for entry cut-off and delivery of exhibits, so please note individual Sections carefully.
- Please note that access to the Showgrounds by car will be available on Thurs 16 Feb, but there is NO CAR ENTRY on Fri 17 Feb. There are dedicated parking spots on the street and volunteers available to assist with cartage as needed.

Prizes

- Prize money can be collected from the Show Office on Sat 18 Feb between 9am and 6pm and Sun 19 Feb between 9-11am.
- Prize money not collected by the end of the Show, will be forfeited.

Picking up exhibits

- All Pavilion Exhibits must be collected from the Pavilion or the Main Hall on Sat 18 Feb between 5pm-6.30pm or Sun 19 Feb between 9am-11am.
- Please note there is no car access for pick up but there are dedicated parking spots on the street and volunteers available to assist with cartage as needed.
- All perishable items remaining unclaimed at 11am Sun 19 Feb will be disposed of.
